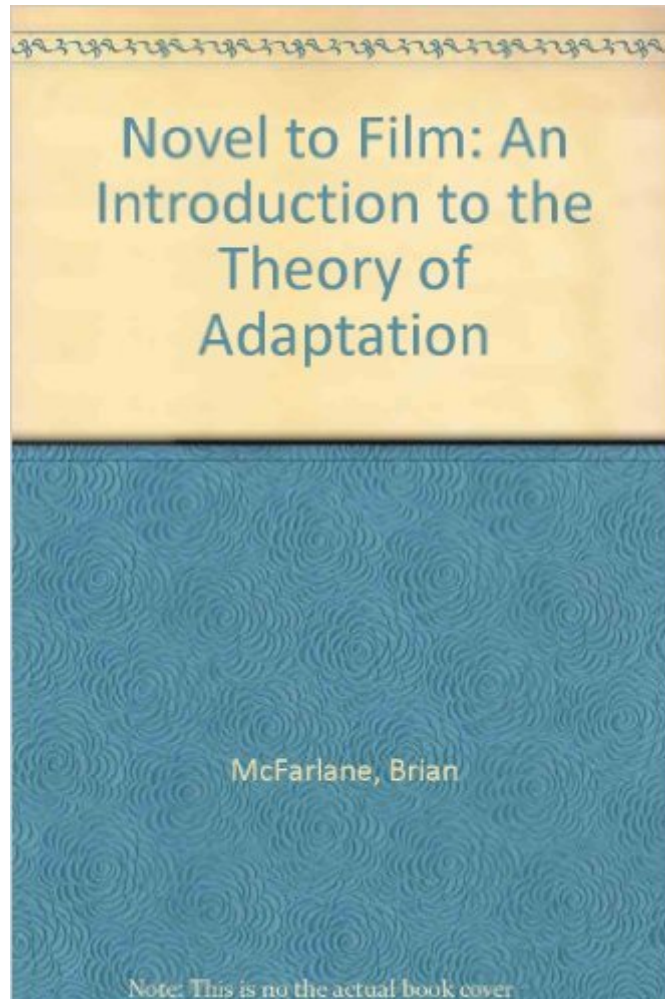


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Novel To Film: An Introduction To The Theory Of Adaptation



Synopsis
