

Twenty-six authors discuss topics such as puppetry and the multiple intelligences; the process versus the product; using puppetry in schools to promote literacy, preserve cultural heritage, and teach music; how puppetry contributes to Core Curriculum Standards, the theoretical underpinnings of therapeutic puppetry, and a range of ways of facilitating growth and development. If you're already using puppets, this book will inspire you to understand your work differently and to explore new possibilities. If you're a teacher or a therapist and you've never used puppets before, it will open a whole world of possibilities. This book illustrates that puppetry arts can affect learning and behavior and that puppets indeed have the power to unlock doors to the mind and heart.

As a puppeteer and educator, I have long admired the work of Judith O'Hare in puppetry in education. This book is an inspiring collection of articles, ranging from Marlene Joyce's description of how her 5th grade class performed an African folktale, to Shelia Harris' use of a mascot puppet in

her classroom, to Suzanne Downs' ideas for using puppets with very young children...and many, many more.
